Requirements on delivery: Completed entry form together with the entry fee and exhibit.

Exhibit delivery: Exhibits to be entered Wednesday 6th September between 12noon – 6pm at the Nancy Gray OAM pavilion at the Showgrounds.

Exhibit collection time: Nancy Gray OAM Pavilion Sunday 10th after 2pm,

All exhibits will to be marked off on collection, prize money and trophies to be collected Sunday with exhibits from chief steward

Conditions of Entry:

- Cleanliness is essentials, work must not be washed unless technique requires it. It may be well pressed.
- One piece of work cannot be entered for more than one class.
- All exhibits should be bona fide of the exhibitor and completed with the last two years
- Stewards have the right to debar any exhibit which in their opinion does not conform to the rules

Prize money – 1st - \$5, 2nd - \$3 unless otherwise stated

6. Embroidered article be a senior citizen (over 70Yrs)
7. Any article of silk ribbon embroidery.
8. Creative hand embroidery on any article.
9. Article of wool embroidery on any medium.
10. Article of stump work

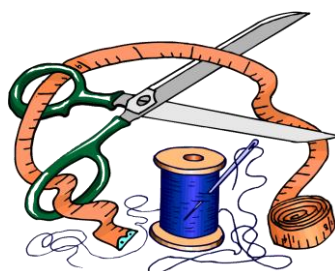

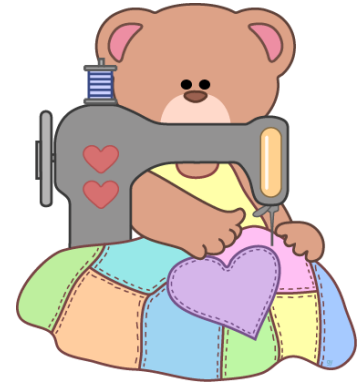


Junior Needlework Section Entry Free

5. Junior knitting or crochet 13 to 18 years
6. Any article with a Christmas Theme 12 year and under
7. Any article with a Christmas Theme 13 to 18 years
8. Any article with a Farming theme 12 years and under
9. Any article with a Farming Theme 13 to 18 years
