- 1) All Rings commence at 8.30 AM except Fashions on the Field which will commence at 8.00am.
- Saturday \$4 per event per exhibit.
- Please purchase tickets prior to your events at the entry desk. Unused tickets will not be refunded.
- 4) Animal indemnity and waiver form must be signed prior to competing. Arm bands will be provided once the form is signed. No arm band, no competing.

Other Important Things:

- · Classes won't be re-run.
- We endeavour to keep the day running quickly. Class numbers will be updated on rings and announcements will be made over the speaker system. We recommend you stay close to the ring to avoid missing your class.
- A class may be split to allow for performance qualifying points HOWEVER REQUESTS TO SPLIT A CLASS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE STEWARD AND JUDGE IN THAT RING PRIOR TO THE SECTION COMMENCING.

- DRUG TESTING MAY BE CARRIED OUT. ANY COMPETITOR FOUND TO HAVE BREACHED THE ASC DISPUTES AND DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS
 - WILL BE INVESTIGATED BY THE ASC DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE. THIS POLICY CAN BE FOUND AT WWW.AGSHOWNSW.ORG.AU.
- The judge's decision is final. All exhibitors are asked to refrain from seeking performance feedback until judging of that class is completed.
- Parents/Carers are asked not to discuss the performance of a child in their care with the Judge or Ring Steward unless prompted by the official themselves
- There will be no scheduled tea breaks. Breaks in the ring are at the discretion of the judge and will be announced once known.

PRIZES

1ST, 2ND AND 3RD PLACE RIBBONS (Tiny tot classes- all will receive a participation ribbon, please see program for these classes) Champion, Reserve will receive a sash unless otherwise stated in program. Please see respective program sections for details.

AWARDS Special awards will be given as stated in the program.

ENTRY TO THE RING Competitors must have an arm band proving they have signed the waiver form.

ENTRY TO THE GROUNDS Please see charges on the show website. Driver plus passengers of car plus float or trucks must pay the advertised gate price on Saturday. As such, entries on Saturday are \$4 per entry ticket.

STABLING Application and payment will only be available through www.nominate.com.au. Stable applications will open August 1st 2022 & will close when all stables are allocated. All fees and descriptions of stables are available on Nominate. **CONTACT Belinda Barnes on 0447 462 235** Please note that stables book out quickly.

CAMPING Sites cannot be booked BUT NIGHTLY FEES HAVE TO BE PAID through www.nominate.com.au You will be issued with a receipt of payment for both camping and stabling **Please print this receipt and leave on the dashboard of your car **

Camping fees are applicable to overnight camping immediately adjacent to the show days THE USE OF ELECTRIC FENCES ON THE SHOWGROUND IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.

HORSES AGE To be calculated on 1st August.

BREED COMPETITORS All horses competing in breed classes must be currently registered with their relevant breed association/society All riders/handlers in breed classes must be current financial members of the relevant breed association/society Failure to comply with this rule will result in disqualification Registration and membership papers must be available on request.

STALLIONS & COLTS Must be led by a bar, chain or bit when required. HANDLERS MUST BE 17 YEARS AND OVER. They are eligible for other classes where stated in the program however are required to wear a stallion disc on both sides of the halter or bridle when not in a stallion specific sex class. Discs are to be worn on Stallions bridles or halters. Temporary discs will be available from entry desk for \$2. Exception to this rule is when competing in a Champion, reserve or Supreme class where other competitors should expect a Stallion/colt to be competing. Stallions are required to be double tied or tied with a collar to trucks and floats.

MARES Mare handlers/exhibitors are asked to respect the space of Stallions and Colts just as you would expect a Stallion or colt handler to respect yours. Mare exhibitors should expect stallions to be included in champion/reserve and supreme classes and classes listed as stallion eligible in the program. If your mare is in season, please identify this to the ring steward prior to entry into these mixed classes so they can notify any stallion exhibitors.

CONTROL OF HORSES Any horse/pony regardless of sex, deemed by officials to be behaving in a manner that is threatening the safety of spectators, other exhibitors and or show officials (eg judges & stewards), will have their rights to compete on that day suspended

HEIGHT CLASSES All exhibits competing in height classes must compete at their correct height

JUDGES & CLASSES The committee reserve the right to substitute a judge if deemed necessary and to delete or combine any class as required. Judges will be announced via our Facebook page.

IMPROPER BEHAVIOUR Outside assistance to competitors by word, radio, mobile device or any other method whilst competing in the ring will not be permitted. Competitors found in breach of this rule will be dismissed from the event and the Showground. Competitors names will be submitted to the A.S.C.

RULES AND INFORMATION All competitors Ride, Drive and Handle at their own risk

GENERAL RING CONDITIONS: Competitors and assistants, please be aware that the ring is to be kept clear of horses and riders/handlers who are always not competing. Marshalling areas immediate to the ring will be provided. Exhibitors and their assistants who are holding or riding horses are asked to stay within this area or back at your float/truck/campsite whilst awaiting events to keep the ring as safe and fair as possible for everyone. Warm up areas will also be provided and clearly marked. These are the only areas to be used for warm up/cool down workouts.

PLEASE REMEMBER THAT THE VOLUNTEERS AT THIS SHOW DO THEIR BEST TO PROVIDE AN ENJOYABLE EVENT FOR EVERYONE AND AGGRESSIVE OR UNSPORTSMANLIKE BEHAVIOUR FROM COMPETITORS OR SPECTATORS TOWARDS ANYONE ATTENDING THE SHOW WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND APPROPRIATE ACTION WILL BE TAKEN INCLUDING BEING DISMISSED FROM THE SHOWGROUND AND EVENTS

DEPARTMENT OF PRIMARY INDUSTRIES DIRECTIVES Competitors are expected to be compliant with all horse movement and/or immunisation directives as current at the date of the show. Please refer to the DPI for current directives

DEFINITIONS: Breeds- Must be registered with respective breed societies/associations and be exhibited and owned by financial members of that society/association **Novice-** Is any horse or rider that has not won a first place in any individual event at any Agricultural Show or Show Horse Council approved/recognized Show **Local events-** For horses and riders who are residents of the Liverpool Plains Shire

PROHIBITED DRUGS IT IS THE INTENTION OF THESE REGULATIONS THAT ALL ANIMALS SHALL PERFORM ON THEIR MERITS WITHOUT THE AID OF DRUGS WHICH WILL AFFECT THE CONDUCT, PERFORMANCE AND APPEARANCE OF THE ANIMAL. AN EXHIBITOR SHALL NOT ADMINISTER AND SHALL PROCURE THAT THERE SHALL NOT BE ADMINISTERED TO HIS/HER EXHIBIT ANY DRUG OR SUBSTANCE HEREIN CALLED A "PROHIBITED DRUG". PROHIBITED DRUGS ARE SUBSTANCES ORIGINATING EXTERNALLY WHETHER OR NOT THEY ARE ENDOGENOUS TO THE ANIMAL AND MEANS ANY SUBSTANCES CAPABLE OF AFFECTING THE PERFORMANCE OR BEHAVIOUR OF AN ANIMAL BY ITS ACTION UPON THE CENTRAL OR PERIPHERAL NERVOUS SYSTEM, THE CARDIO-

VASCULAR SYSTEM, THE RESPIRATORY SYSTEM, THE ALIMENTARY- DIGESTIVE SYSTEM, THE MUSCULO-SKELETAL SYSTEM OR THE UROGENITAL SYSTEM AND SHALL INCLUDE ANALGESICS, ANTI-HISTAMINES, ANTI- INFLAMMATORY AGENTS, BLOOD COAGULANTS, DIURETICS, HORMONES AND THEIR SYNTHETIC COUNTERPARTS, CORTICO-STEROIDS, ANABOLIC STEROIDS, LOCAL ANAESTHETICS, MUSCLE RELAXANTS AND TRANQUILLISERS AND VITAMINS. THE USE OF ANTIBIOTIC SUBSTANCES (ANTI- VIRAL, ANTI-MICROBIAL, ANTI-PARASITIC) WITH THE EXCEPTION OF PROCAINE PENICILLIN MAY BE PERMITTED. IN THE CASE OF SHOWJUMPING ENTRIES ONLY. WHICH ARE CONDUCTED UNDER F.E.I. RULES, THE USE OF PHENYLBUTAZONE AND OXYPHENYLBUTAZONE IS PERMITTED PROVIDED THE MAXIMUM LEVEL OF EITHER OR BOTH DOES NOT EXCEED 2 MICROGRAMS PER MILLILITRE OF PLASMA, IN AGGREGATE, AT THE TIME IN WHICH THE EXHIBIT IS TO BE JUDGED. THE QUIRINDI SHOW SOCIETY INC (OR CENTRAL NORTHERN GROUP OF SHOW SOCIETIES INC) MAY AT ITS DISCRETION CAUSE AN EXAMINATION TO BE MADE OF AN EXHIBIT BY A VETERINARY OFFICER WHO IN THE COURSE OF SUCH EXAMINATION MAY MAKE BY SUCH METHODS AS HE/SHE MAY DETERMINE SUCH TESTS OF AND TAKE SUCH SAMPLES FROM SUCH EXHIBIT AS HE/SHE DEEMS NECESSARY OR ADVISABLE. THE RESULT OF THE EXAMINATION SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE GROUP AND THE SOCIETY. AN EXHIBIT TO WHICH, IN THE OPINION OF THE VETERINARY

OFFICER, A PROHIBITED DRUG HAS BEEN ADMINISTERED SHALL NOT BE EXHIBITED WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE GROUP AND SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE SHOWGROUND FORTHWITH UPON NOTICE FROM THE GROUP OR SOCIETY. THE GROUP MAY AT ITS SOLE DISCRETION IMPOSE THE PENALTIES APPLICABLE IN THE LIGHT OF ALL INFORMATION MADE AVAILABLE AND MAY DISALLOW OR CANCEL THE ENTRY AND ANY AWARD MADE TO THE EXHIBIT, WITHOUT IN SUCH CASE BEING CALLED UPON TO GIVE REASON THEREFORE. THE OWNER OR ANY OTHER PERSON WHO WAS IN CHARGE OF THE ANIMAL TO WHICH A PROHIBITED DRUG HAS BEEN ADMINISTERED WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND PENALTIES SHALL APPLY. THE PENALTIES TO APPLY SHALL BE 12 MONTHS" DISQUALIFICATION FROM EXHIBITING WITHIN THIS GROUP FOR THE ANIMAL AND THE PERSON IN CHARGE OF THE ANIMAL. IT WILL BE RECOMMENDED TO THE AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES" COUNCIL OF N.S.W. THAT THESE PENALTIES SHALL APPLY ON A STATE-WIDE LEVEL AND THAT DISQUALIFICATION SHOULD BE STATE-WIDE. IF THE ANIMAL IS NOT PRESENTED FOR EXAMINATION WITHIN THE TIME SPECIFIED BY THE GROUP, THEN THE SAME PENALTIES SHALL APPLY AS IF A PROHIBITED DRUG WAS DETECTED. NO "TREATMENT FORMS" WILL BE ACCEPTABLE. ANY PERSON WHO AT ANY TIME ADMINISTERS OR CAUSES TO BE ADMINISTERED FOR THE PURPOSE OF AFFECTING THE PERFORMANCE OF AN ANIMAL IN ANY EVENT OR CLASS AT THE SHOW ANY DRUG AS DEFINED PREVIOUSLY OR HAS IN HIS/HER POSSESSION ANY IMPROPER CONTRIVANCE MAY BE DISQUALIFIED OR OTHERWISE PENALIZED BY THE GROUP. PARTICULAR ATTENTION WILL BE PAID TO THE DETECTION OF SEDATIVE AND TRANQUILLISER GROUPS OF DRUGS BUT ANALYSIS FOR ALL CLASSES OF PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES WILL BE INCLUDED. THE COLLECTION OF SAMPLES, INTER ALIA, WILL ALWAYS INVOLVE TAKING URINE AND/OR BLOOD. AN EXAMINATION MAY INCLUDE AN EXAMINATION FOR DESENSITISED LIMBS. ANY ANIMAL FOUND TO HAVE A LIMB OR PART OF A LIMB DESENSITISED BY ANY MEANS WILL BE CONSIDERED TO HAVE COMPETED UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF A PROHIBITED SUBSTANCE AND PENALIZED ACCORDINGLY, THE OWNER OR HIS/HER REPRESENTATIVE MAY BE PRESENT DURING TESTING, BUT SHALL NOT INTERFERE IN ANY WAY WITH THE CONDUCT OF THE TEST, AND WILL OBSERVE THE INSTRUCTIONS OF THE VETERINARY OFFICER ON DUTY. THE SOCIETY (OR GROUP) AND ANY SERVANT OR APPOINTEE OF THE SOCIETY OR GROUP SHALL NOT BE LIABLE TO THE EXHIBITOR, OWNER OR OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES, FOR THE DEATH OF, OR FOR ANY INJURY, DAMAGE OR INFECTION WHICH MAY BE SUSTAINED BY AN EXHIBIT OCCASIONED BY OR ARISING

OUT OF ANY ACT OR OMISSION OF ANY SERVANT, AGENT OR APPOINTEE OF THE SOCIETY OR GROUP DONE OR COMMITTED IN THE COURSE OF HIS/HER EXAMINATION WHETHER DUE TO THE NEGLIGENCE OF ANY SUCH SERVANT, AGENT OR APPOINTEE OR OTHERWISE. EXHIBITORS MUST ABIDE BY THE DIRECTIONS OF THE SOCIETY OR GROUP AS TO THE PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED FOR THE EXAMINATION OF THEIR EXHIBIT AND FAILURE TO ADHERE TO THIS DIRECTION SHALL INCUR THE SAME PENALTIES AS IF PROHIBITED DRUGS WERE DETECTED.




